Dear Patients

“We are very pleased to **reopen on Friday 11th June 2021** for all our regular dental services. This most recent lockdown has been difficult for both our patients and Blackburn Dental Group staff. We thank you all for your support.

All our patients are screened by our receptionists when they make appointments and the day before their appointment. You will be asked to confirm that you are free of symptoms and have not been to an exposure site. If you have symptoms and have not been to an exposure site, you must get tested and isolate until you have a negative result before we can see you. You must wear a mask on entry to our practice and you will also need to login to the Victorian QR code on your smartphone.

Exposure sites – Tiers 1,2 and 3 explained.

-Tier 1 exposure sites

Anyone who has visited a Tier 1 exposure site during the times listed must immediately isolate, [get a COVID-19 test](#), and quarantine for 14 days from the date of exposure. You should also contact the Department of Health on [1300 651 160](tel:1300651160).

-Tier 2 exposure sites

Anyone who has visited a Tier 2 exposure site during times listed should urgently [get a COVID-19 test](#) and isolate until they receive a negative result. You should also contact the Department of Health on [1300 651 160](tel:1300651160).

Continue to monitor for symptoms, get tested again if symptoms appear.

-Tier 3 exposure sites

Anyone who has visited a Tier 3 exposure site during times listed should monitor for symptoms. If symptoms develop, immediately [get a COVID-19 test](#) and isolate until you receive a negative result.”
